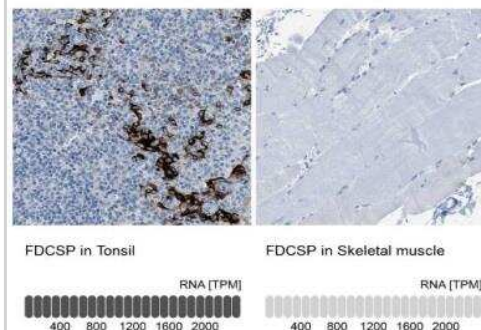

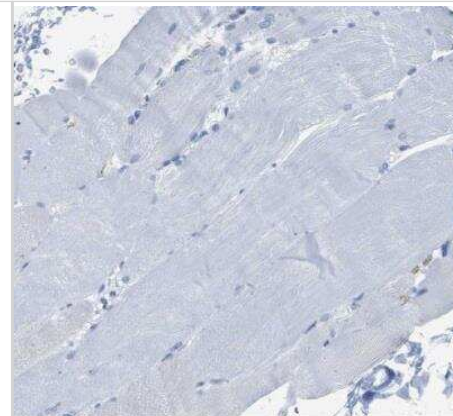

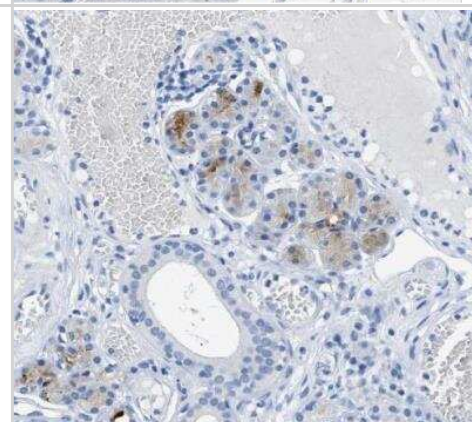

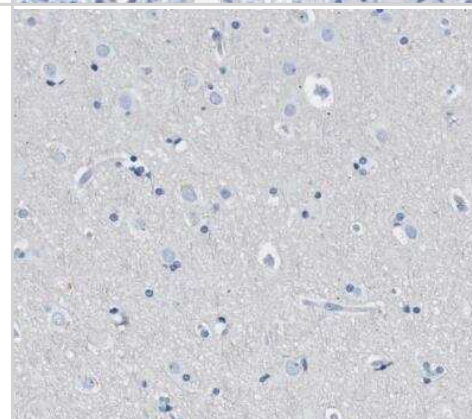

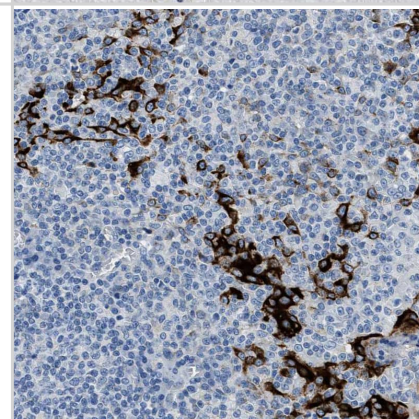

Staining of human tonsil shows strong cytoplasmic positivity in squamous epithelial cells.
