





Immunoprecipitation: HDAC7 Antibody [NBP2-16795] - 1000 ug 293T whole cell lysate/extract A. 50 ug 293T whole cell lysate/extract B. Control with 2 ug of preimmune rabbit IgG C. Immunoprecipitation of HDAC7 protein by 2 ug of HDAC7 antibody 10% SDS-PAGE The immunoprecipitated HDAC7 protein was detected by HDAC7 antibody diluted at 1:1000. anti-rabbit IgG was used as a secondary reagent.



Whole cell extract (30 ug) was separated by 7.5% SDS-PAGE, and the membrane was blotted with HDAC7 antibody [C2C3], C-term (NBP2-16795) diluted at 1:1000. The HRP-conjugated anti-rabbit IgG antibody was used to detect the primary antibody.
