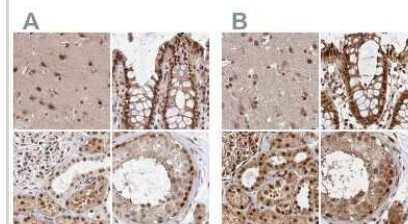

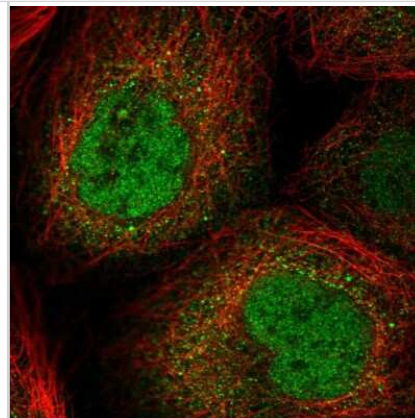

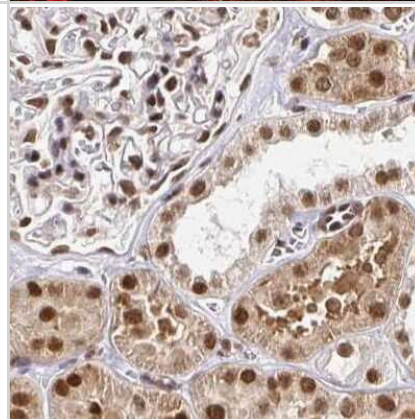

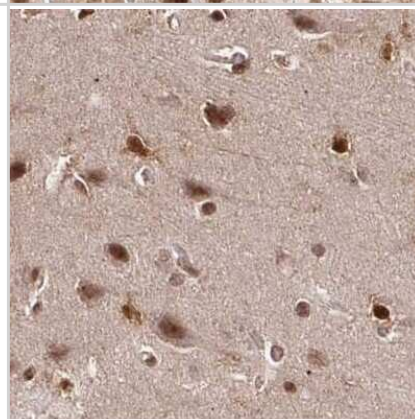

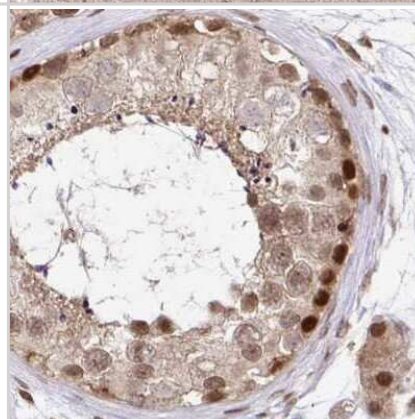
Immunohistochemistry-Paraffin: N-PAC Antibody [NBP2-38576] - Staining of human kidney.



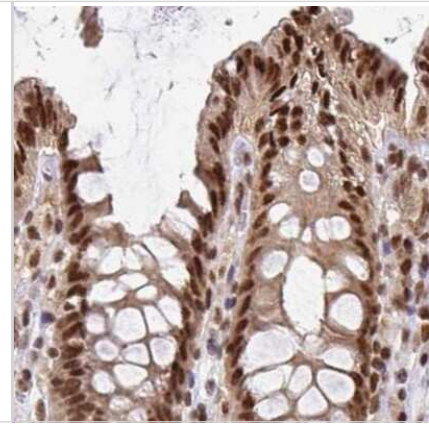
Immunohistochemistry-Paraffin: N-PAC Antibody [NBP2-38576] - Staining of human cerebral cortex.
