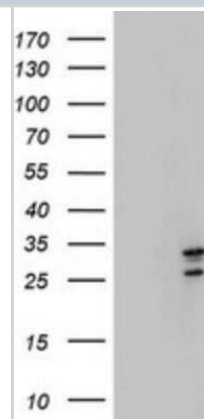

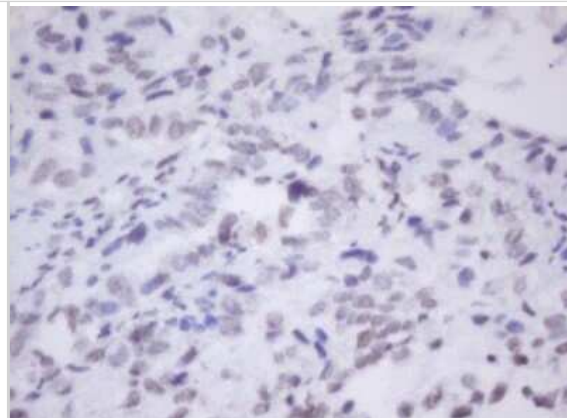

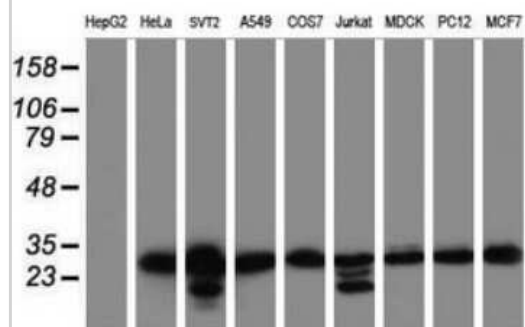

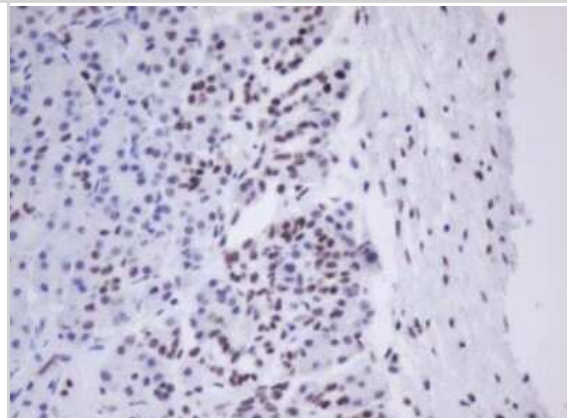
Immunohistochemistry: MORF4 Antibody (5F2) [NBP2-45818] - Analysis of Adenocarcinoma of Human ovary tissue.



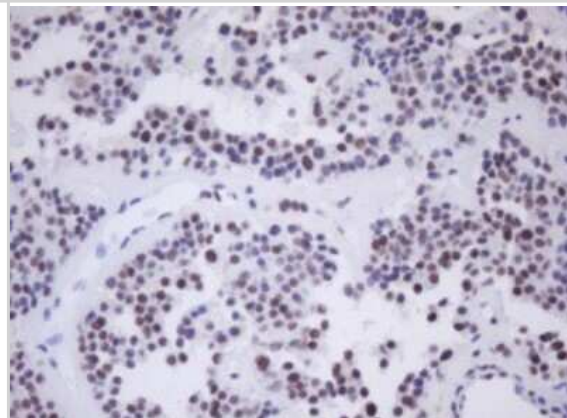

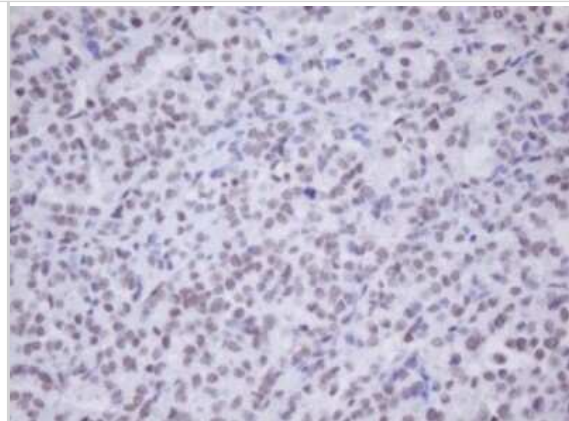
Immunohistochemistry: MORF4 Antibody (5F2) [NBP2-45818] - Analysis of Human pancreas tissue.
