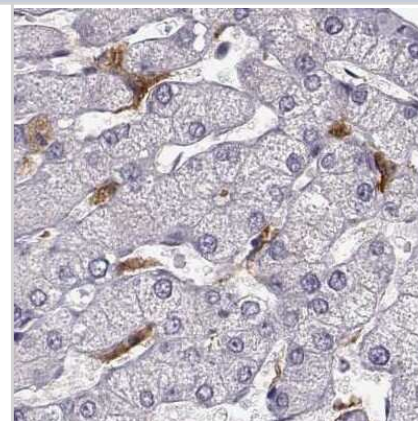

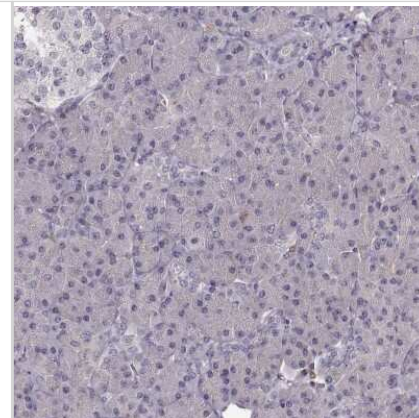

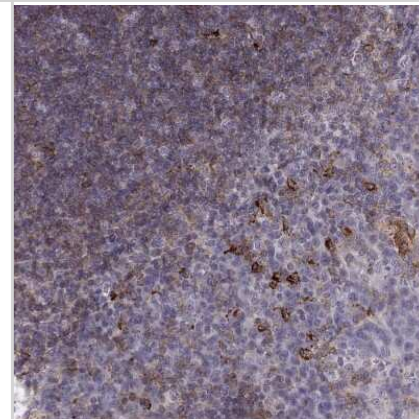
Immunohistochemistry-Paraffin: Cyclin F Antibody [NBP2-57569] - Staining of human liver.



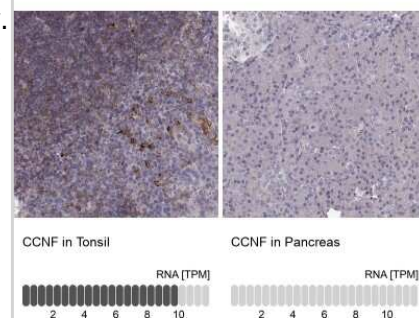
Immunohistochemistry-Paraffin: Cyclin F Antibody [NBP2-57569] - Staining of human pancreas shows low expression as expected.



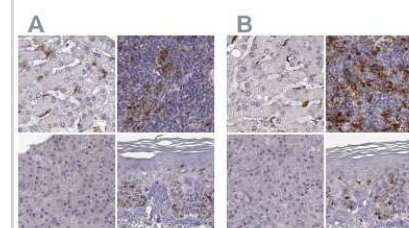
Immunohistochemistry-Paraffin: Cyclin F Antibody [NBP2-57569] - Staining of human tonsil shows high expression.



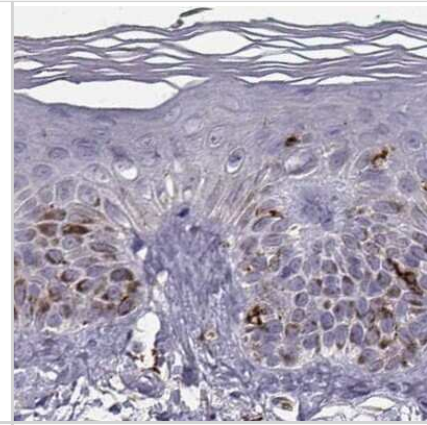

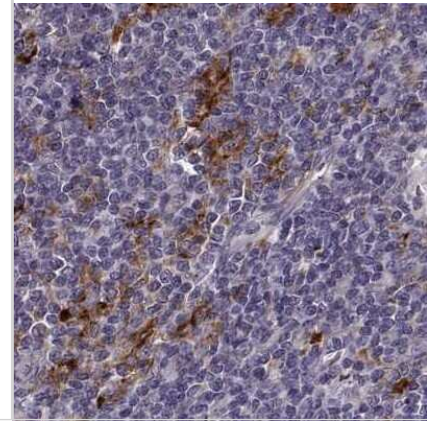
