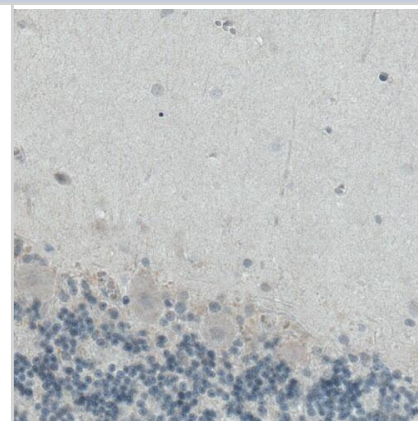

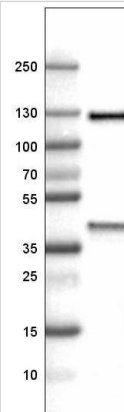

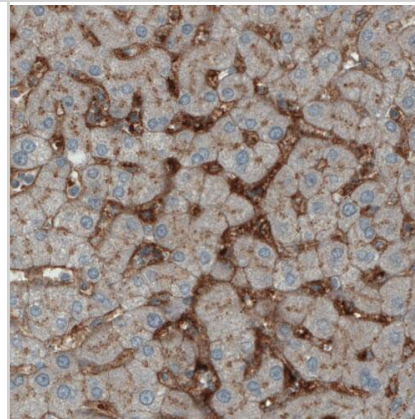
Staining of human cerebellum shows absence of immunoreactivity (negative control).



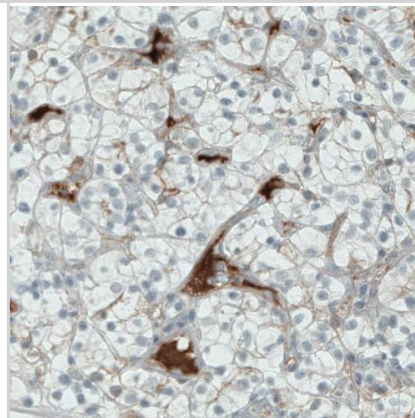
Lane 1: Marker [kDa]  
Lane 2: Human liver tissue lysate



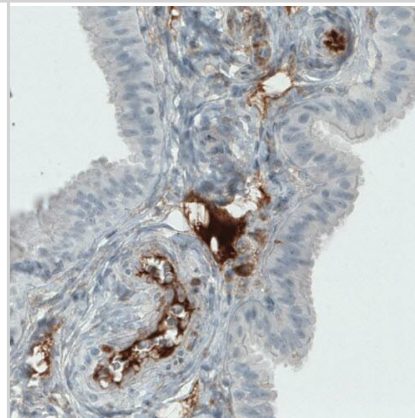
Staining of human liver shows immunoreactivity in sinusoids.
