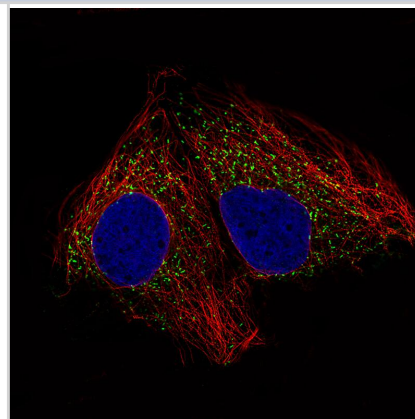

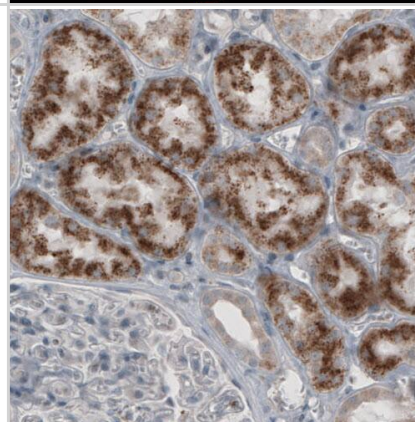

Staining of CACO-2 cells using the Anti-ACAA1 monoclonal antibody) .

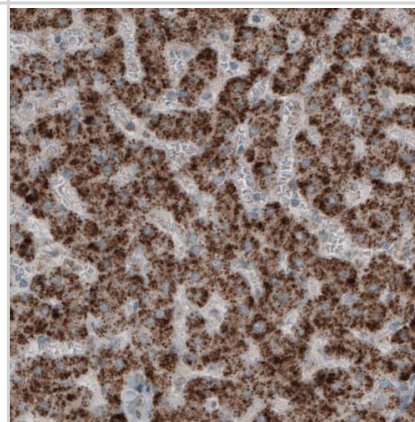


Staining of human kidney shows granular cytoplasmic immunoreactivity in renal tubules.

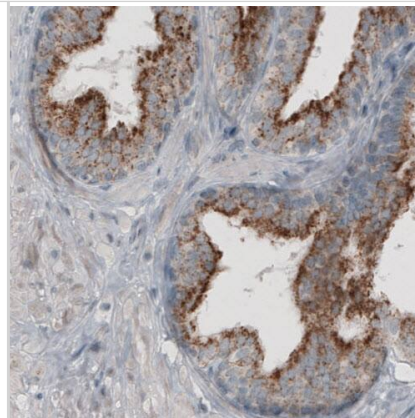


Staining of human colon shows granular cytoplasmic immunoreactivity in glandular cells. 

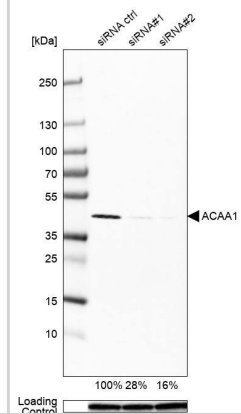
Staining of human liver shows strong granular cytoplasmic positivity in hepatocytes.
