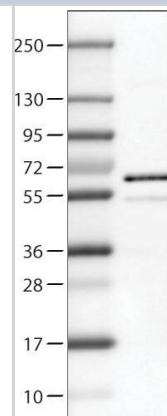

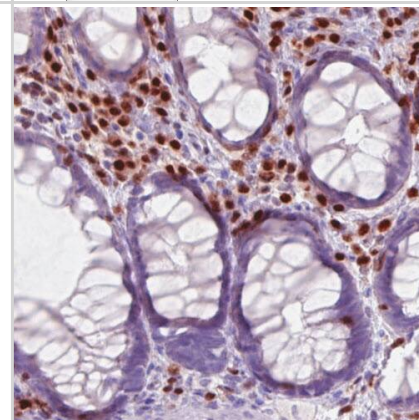

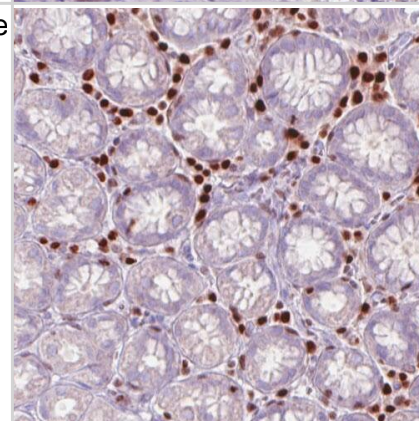
Lane 1: Marker [kDa]
Lane 2: Human cell line U-251 MG



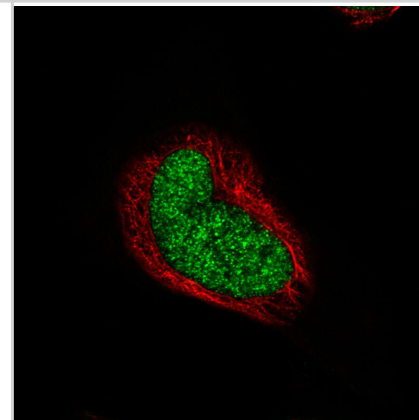
Staining of human colon shows strong nuclear immunoreactivity in the lymphoid cells.



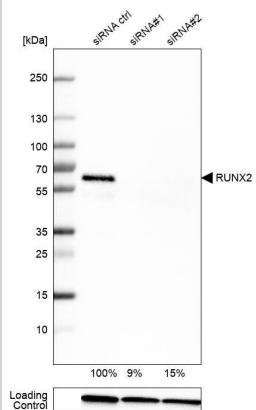
Staining of human stomach shows strong nuclear immunoreactivity in the lymphoid cells.



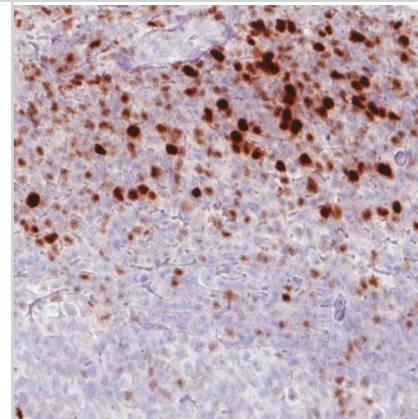
Staining of RH-30 cells using the Anti-RUNX2/CBFA1 monoclonal antibody .
